



The Question

Is belief in God a rational response to reality, or an outmoded delusion spread throughout the population by viruses of the mind, based on flimsy and naive reasoning, and



imposed by authoritarian institutions and individuals?



1. God's existence & RATIONAL FAITH.

- ✓ The issue is not faith or reason but rather 1) breadth of perspective, 2) logic, and 3) commitment.
- ✓ Belief in God is not a blind irrational leap, but a rational commitment to evidence from creation & conscience.
- ✓ We have "witnesses" (clues) to, not "proofs" of, God's existence.
- ✓ Not everyone will have "ears to hear" or "eyes to see" the witnesses.

"The Scripture and science do not give us "proofs", they give us data and clues. Proofs are a function of commitment."

2. God's existence & SPIRITUAL ANTENNA

Isaiah 55:9

"For as the heavens are higher than the earth, so are My ways higher than your ways. and My thoughts than your thoughts."

Our "spiritual antenna" is tuned to God's station, but we keep changing the channel.

25 For **they exchanged** the truth of God for a lie, and worshiped and served the creature rather than the Creator,"



Consider:

- It seems natural for children to believe in God.
- Religion is common in history and culture.
- Humans seem to assume an immaterial (spiritual) root to reason and reality.
- Humans have strong impulses concerning moral values and immortal life.
- Modern science was birthed in the Christian tradition's ordered cosmos, rational thought, and desire to understand God.

- ✓ The universe is ordered.
- \checkmark The universe is designed for life.
- \checkmark The universe is seen as beautiful.
- ✓ We have a moral / spiritual sense.


Acknowledging God's existence brings us meaning, significance, & hope for those who long for it.


Romans 2


The divine image is imprinted not only in the creation but also in




