  - √ In our influence How much OF **YOU** should I expect to change?
    - √ In God's providence How much of our CIRCUMSTANCES should we expect God to change?

Expectations are at the heart of the Christian Gospel

- √ Faith & Hope = expectations
- **✓ Covenant & Promises = expectations**
- √ Peace & Ministry = expectations

### Hebrews 11

"36 and others experienced mockings and scourgings, yes, also chains and imprisonment. 37 They were stoned, they were sawn in two, they were tempted, they were put to death with the sword; they went about in sheepskins, in goatskins, being destitute, afflicted, ill-treated 38 (men of whom the world was not worthy), wandering in deserts and mountains and caves and holes in the ground.

39 And all these, having gained approval through their faith, did not receive what was promised, 40 because God had provided something better for us, so that apart from us they should not be made perfect."



# Things that a Berean should avoid in building Godly Expectations.

- Bibliolatry Treating the Bible as an encyclopedia of proof texts without a context.
- Old Covenant Centering kingdom hope on this world, life, and age.
  - Assuming that all Scripture is directed to and about us.
  - Conflating God's will with our will.
- Distorting the Gospel False expectations come from a false Gospel.
