#### 1 Corinthians 5

"9 I wrote you in my letter not to associate with immoral people; 10 I did not at all mean with the immoral people of this world, or with the covetous and swindlers, or with idolaters; for then you would have to go out of the world.

11 But actually, I wrote to you not to associate with any so-called (named as a) brother if he should be an immoral person, or covetous, or an idolater, or a reviler, or a drunkard, or a swindler — not even to eat with such a one.

12 For what have I to do with judging outsiders? Do you not judge those who are within the church? 13 But those who are outside, God judges."

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

- This a universal distinctive of HUMANITY.
- The U.S. constitution respects this fact as 1) "self evident" and 2) the basis of our republic's social ethic.
  - Our domestic and foreign policy is based on this truth.
    - As citizens we are expected to live and legislate this truth as a part of "the general welfare".
      - Christian appeals to the state are limited by this boundary.

Its execution is in the hands of Government empowered by the people.



**Old Covenant MATERIAL** over spiritual, Focus on legal controls


# **New Covenant**
