Acts 24



Kingdom Power demands that we GET OUT OF THE WAY.


Romans 12:1








1 Corinthians 4

"8 You are already filled, you have already become rich, you have become kings without us; ... 9 For, I think, God has exhibited us apostles last of all, as men **condemned to death**; because we have become a spectacle to the world, both to angels and to men. 10 We are **fools for Christ's sake**, but you are prudent in Christ; we are weak, but you are strong; you are distinguished, but we are without honor. 11 To this present hour we are both hungry and thirsty, and are poorly clothed, and are roughly treated, and are homeless; 12 and we toil, working with our own hands; when we are **reviled**, we bless; when we are persecuted, we endure; 13 when we are slandered, we try to conciliate; we have become as the scum of the world, the dregs of all things, even until now." 14

"6 Therefore we do not lose heart, but though our outer man is decaying, yet our inner man is being renewed day by day. 17 For momentary, light affliction is producing for us an eternal weight of glory far beyond all comparison. 18 while we look not at the things which are seen, but at the things which are not seen; for the things which are seen are temporal, but the things which are not seen are eternal."


5. The Way of the Cross is tied to the **NEW COVENANT**
