


2. Easter's hope is at the core of the Christian Gospel's uniqueness.


1 Corinthians 15


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
Paul understood his Gospel to have been a mystery until his day.





the Good News of the promised hope of God's blessing through the seed of Abraham & the Law of Moses


Pre Easter (Jesus)


revealed in the person of Jesus Christ
