
## Reaching our generation with the Gospel from a Berean perspective.


- · Jesus' model was SHOW and TELL in that order.
- The Apostles' emphasis was more on the formation and health of the Body of Christ than on world missions. Rom.12, Eph.4


Let your light shine.

#### 1. Social relationships

- Rushing to declare an opinion and attack all who disagree shuts off growth for both.






