
We are told that we are saved by grace through faith apart from our works.

But when the Bible speaks of the final judgment it is *almost always* on the basis of our works, not our faith.



Bereans look at the Biblical fine print and often feel confused if not misled.





As Bereans let's look at the Word of God.

Hebrews 6

"1 Therefore leaving the **elementary teaching** about the Christ, let us press on to maturity, not laying again a foundation of repentance from dead works and of faith toward God, 2 of instruction about washings, and laying on of hands, and the resurrection of the dead, and eternal judgment."

We need to clarify the "fine print" of:

- Our REPENTANCE from dead works & faith
- God's JUDGMENT of believers

Two levels of REPENTANCE / faith & works

REPENT & BELIEVE



for FAMILY identity. "Strategic" (initiation, once)

- ★ Hope
- **★** Conversion

repent & behave



for FRUITFUL living. "Tactical" (several times)

- ★ Ethics
- **★** Communion

Two common erroneous doctrines

Saving faith is notarized by holy living.

Catholic sainthood or purgatory.

Protestant election or Holy Spirit enabled.



One adds to God's grace.

One subtracts from God's glory.


Two levels of JUDGMENT / faith & works

Revelation 20

"11 And I saw a great white throne,...12 And I saw the dead, small and great, stand before God; and the books were opened:

and another book was opened, which is the book of life;

and the dead were judged from the things which were written in the books, according to their deeds. And death and Hades were thrown into the lake of fire. This is the second death


1 Corinthians 15:22

Romans 5:19

All who are in Adam die.

1 Corinthians 4

"3 But to me it is a very small thing that I should be examined by you, or by any human court; in fact, I do not even examine myself. 4 I am conscious of nothing against myself, yet I am not by this acquitted; but the one who examines me is the Lord.

God (not we or others) is the judge.

5 Therefore do not go on passing judgment before the time, but wait until the Lord comes who **will both bring to light the things hidden in the darkness and disclose the motives of men's hearts**; and then each man's praise will come to him from God."

God will expose the hidden deeds & motives of our lives (and much more).

The "bema" judgment exposes our works and God's glory.

1Corinthians 13:12

"For now we see in a mirror dimly, but then face to face; now I know in part, but **then I shall know** fully just as I also have been fully known."

Tears will be wiped away and displaced by God's glory and grace.

Revelation 21:4

"He will wipe away every tear from their eyes;"

Romans 14:11

"... every knee shall bow to Me, and every tongue shall give praise to God."

What will believers be judged for?

1 Corinthians 3

"7 So then neither the one who plants nor the one who waters is anything, but God who causes the growth. 8 Now he who plants and he who waters are one; but **each will receive his own reward according to his own labor**. 9 For we are God's fellow workers; you are God's field, God's building."

Our HEART and BODY for God's GLORY and BODY

Moral virtue in mirroring Christ's holiness Ministry value in building the Body of Christ

1 Corinthians 3

"10 According to the grace of God which was given to me, like a wise master builder I laid a foundation, and another is building on it. But each man must be careful how he builds on it. 11 For no man can lay a foundation other than the one which is laid, which is Jesus Christ. 12 Now if any man **builds upon the foundation** with gold, silver, precious stones, wood, hay, straw, 13 each man's work will become evident; for the day will show it, because it is to be revealed with fire; and the fire itself will test the quality of each man's work."

The "bema" judgment exposes our works and God's glory.

The Bema judgment is not about saving grace and faith but about how we build on it.

Gal. 5:16-26

"25 If we live by the Spirit, let us also walk by the Spirit."

Works of the Spirit
Items of the Spirit The Foundation by the Spirit."

1 Corinthians 3:8

"Now he who plants and he who waters are one; but each will receive his own **reward according to** his own labor."

The result of a believer's behavior is loss or reward (fruit, not redemption).

1 Corinthians 3

"14 If any man's work which he has built upon it remains, he shall **receive a reward**. 15 If any man's work is burned up, he shall **suffer loss**; but **he himself shall be saved**, yet so as through fire."

Our behavior (good or bad) will not alter salvation by grace through faith.

The Points

The Gospel is good news for sinners.
Salvation is by grace through faith apart from our good or evil works.

Our peace rests with God's full PARDON (not His provision or parole).

True (saving) faith will bear fruit that only God can judge.

The exposure of our behavior brings a fuller awareness of God's grace, not a fear of God's wrath.
