## Satan tempted Eve by first generating false expectations based on optics.

Genesis 3

"4 serpent said to the woman, "You surely will not die! 5 For God knows that in the day you eat from it your eyes will be opened, and you will be like God, knowing good and evil." 6 When the woman saw that the tree was good for food, and that it was a delight to the eyes, and that the tree was desirable to make one wise, she took from its fruit and ate; and she gave also to her husband with her, and he ate. 7 Then the eyes of both of them were opened, and they knew that they were naked; and they sewed fig leaves together and made themselves loin coverings."

A secularized culture tends to walk by sight not faith neglecting values that our founding fathers knew were needed as a foundation for the American experiment. The shipwreck of Adam, Eve, & Us.

#### Ephesians 5

#### We are ALIENS in a hostile world -

17 So then do not be foolish, but understand what the will of the Lord is. 18 And do not **get drunk with wine**, for that is **dissipation**,

What should we learn from this week's lesson?

- · Change is a battlefield in spiritual warfare.

- Scripture can be Satan's tool if it is not read properly or applied wisely.
