

## Is God a means to it?

It is available through God via "selective" proof texts + faith.

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Satan has no problem with signs & wonders through standing on the promises -

- so long as the promises are turning "stones to bread" ie. expecting to find true life primarily in "this world".
- so long as it leaves people with shame or confusion if God doesn't meet expectations.

## "Sovereign Grace"

means God's control over every aspect of life, both good and evil.

Satan has no problem with "sovereignty" as the core element to God's nature and glory if it -

- ultimately ties Him to sin and evil.
- undermines God's glory in creating humans as His image bearers with freedom to respond to Him.

### Divine sovereignty seems well attested in Scripture.

"this man, delivered over by the predetermined plan and foreknowledge of God"


#### Ephesians 1:4

"just as He chose us in Him before the foundation of the world, that we should be holy and blameless before Him.'


Ephesians 1:11

Satan would have us read too much into the implications of these passages and distort the image of God, His Kingdom, and the Gospel.



Sovereign Grace "proof text" IN CONTEXT

### John (O.T. believers)

6:37 "All that the Father gives Me shall come to Me, and the one who comes to Me I will certainly not cast out."

10:27 "My sheep hear My voice, and I know them, and they follow Me;"

- These texts probably refer to the believing "remnant" in Israel who were already justified by faith (like Abraham).
- Upon hearing Jesus, they recognized him as the promised Messiah, and followed him.

## Ephesians 1 (Jesus is the elect)

"4 just as He **chose** us **in Him** before the foundation of the world, that we should be holy and blameless before Him in love. 5 He **predestined** us to adoption as sons **through Jesus Christ** to Himself, according to the kind intention of His will, 6 to the praise of the glory of His grace, which He freely bestowed on us **in the Beloved**."

1 Peter 2:4 (Isa.42:1, Lk.9:35)

Jesus is "a living stone,...rejected by men, but **choice (elect)**...in the sight of God."

The chosen (elect)

Jesus Christ

"IN CHRIST", the chosen one.

They are "in Christ" if and when they believe.

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Sovereign Grace "proof text" IN CONTEXT

### Romans 9 (Corporate election)

"6 But it is not as though the word of God has failed. For they are not all **Israel** who are descended from **Israel**; 7 neither are they all children because they are **Abraham's descendants**, but: "through **Isaac** your descendants will be named." 8 That is, it is not the **children of the flesh** who are children of God, but the **children of the promise** are regarded as descendants." (Jacob was Israel, Esau / Edom was Gentile.)

"16 So then it does not depend on the man who wills or the man who runs, but on God who has mercy.... 30 What shall we say then? That Gentiles, who did not pursue righteousness, attained righteousness, even the righteousness which is by faith; 31 but Israel, pursuing a law of righteousness, did not arrive at that law. 32 Why? Because they did not pursue it by faith, but as though it were by works."

Romans 9-11 addresses the question -

How does Paul's Gospel (which includes Gentiles) fit with the promise God made to Abraham (which Jews believed to exclude Gentiles)?

Romans 9 is not about individual election but about God's plan of salvation by faith.

Mark 16

"15 And He said to them, "Go into all the world and preach the gospel **to all creation**. 16 **He who has believed** and has been baptized shall be saved; but he who has disbelieved shall be condemned."

## What is the take home of this lesson? **Be a Berean**


Calvinists point to the rigid decrees of God, while Arminians point to the relational dynamics of God.

Both are right in what they affirm but wrong in what they deny.

The Bible gives us a theology which is more human than Calvinism, and more divine than Arminianism, and more Christian than either of them.
