


Paul's commission (and ours)

1 Timothy 1

"1 Paul, an **apostle** of Christ Jesus according to the **commandment** (commission) of God our Savior, and of Christ Jesus, who is our **hope**;

2 to Timothy, my true child in **the faith**: **Grace**, **mercy** and **peace** from God the Father and Christ Jesus our Lord."



GREAT COMMANDMENT Love for God and His people

Matthew 22

"36 "Teacher, which is the great commandment in the Law?" 37 And He said to him, "You shall love the Lord your God with all your heart, and with all your soul, and with all your mind.' 38 This is the great and foremost commandment. 39 The second is like it, 'You shall love your neighbor as yourself.' 40 On these two commandments depend the whole Law and the Prophets."

Matthew 28


"18 And Jesus came up and spoke to them, saying, "All authority has been given to Me in heaven and on earth. 19 **Go** therefore and **make disciples of all the nations**, baptizing them in the name of the Father and the Son and the Holy Spirit, 20 **teaching them to observe all that I commanded you;** and lo, I am with you always, even to the end of the age.""

• Until the 17th cent. this text was applied to the Apostles only and it was "fulfilled" in their lifetime.

Romans 16:25-26

"my Gospel . . . according to the commandment of God . . **HAS BEEN** made known to all the nations."


 The term "Great Commission" was not made common until the 19th cent. by Hudson Taylor.



Ephesians 2:20-21

"having been built on the **foundation** of the apostles and prophets, Christ Jesus Himself being the **corner stone**, in whom the whole building, being fitted together, is growing into a holy **temple** in the Lord."

The epistles of the New Testament (Apostolic teachings) are the foundation of Christian theology.



John 14

"25 These things I have spoken to you, while abiding with you. 26 But the Helper, the Holy Spirit, whom the Father will send in My name, **He will teach you all things, and bring to your remembrance all that I said to you**."

John 16:13

"But when He, the Spirit of truth, comes, He will guide you into all the truth; . . . and **He will disclose to you what is to come**."

This can be understood as Jesus' endorsement of the apostles' teaching.

1 Corinthians 12:4-6

"Now there are **varieties of gifts**, but the same Spirit. And there are **varieties of ministries**, and the same Lord. And there are **varieties of effects**, but the **same God who works all things in all persons**."

1 Peter 4:11
