

#### 1 Corinthians 1

## The Christian Gospel presented three stumbling stones for Jews

- 1. God appearing in a human form.
- 2. Gentile inclusion in the Abrahamic blessings.
- 3. Glory granted by imputed "faith righteousness".


## Jesus

- 1. As bearers of God's Image all humans are closer to God than we might think.
- 2. We are capable of fellowship with God.

### **Divine Humility**

- 3. God's desire for fellowship with us is stronger than we might think.
- 4. We do not deserve redemptive love, but we are worth saving.

### Romans 10

"11 For the Scripture says, "Whoever believes in Him will not be disappointed." 12 For there is no distinction between Jew and Greek; for the same Lord is Lord of all, abounding in riches for all who call upon Him; . . . 14 How then shall they call upon Him in whom they have not believed? And how shall they believe in Him whom they have not heard? And how shall they hear without a preacher? 15 And how shall they preach unless they are sent? Just as it is written, "How beautiful are the feet of those who bring glad tidings of good things!""

### **Universal Gospel**

- 1. He has the whole world in His sights.
- 2. We all have the same need and are offered the same blessed hope.

### **World Ambassadors**

3. Those who know this "good news" need to both show it and spread it.

## IMPUTATION of righteousness through faith

#### Romans 4

"3 For what does the Scripture say? "And Abraham believed God, and it was reckoned to him as righteousness." 4 Now to the one who works, his wage is not reckoned as a favor, but as what is due. 5 But to the one who does not work, but believes in Him who justifies the ungodly, his faith is reckoned as righteousness,"

## Four kinds of righteousness

1. God's perfect character

This is the just standard of God for all of us.

2. Man's relative virtue

This is the false righteousness of the proud.


3. The imputed virtue of Christ


This is the gift of salvation to all who believe.


4. The implemented life of the Spirit

This is the fruit of justification by faith.

## IMPUTATION of righteousness through faith

- √ It is not a "felt" experience.
- ✓ It is complete and not progressive.
- √ It is not dependent on human merit.
- √ It is not secured by moral reform.
- √ It fully satisfies the demands of a perfectly holy God.
- √ It is revealed through teaching and received by FAITH.

## Major on majors not minors (This is MAJOR stuff)

- 1. Jesus reveals God and our humanity "in Christ". KNOW YOURSELF AND GOD.
- 2. Jesus is God's response to the human dilemma. ACCEPT YOURSELF "IN CHRIST".
- 3. Jesus offers hope beyond this life. GET OVER YOURSELF IN THIS LIFE.
