#### Philippians 2:17


"But even if I am being **poured out as a drink offering** upon the sacrifice and service of your faith, I rejoice and share my joy with you all.

## The final judgment - open the books Revelation 20

"11 And I saw a **great white throne** and Him who sat upon it, from whose presence earth and heaven fled away, and no place was found for them. 12 And I saw the dead, the great and the small, standing before the throne, and **books were opened**; and **another book** was opened, which is the **book of life**; and the dead were judged from the things which were written in **the books**, according to their deeds. 13 And the sea gave up the dead which were in it, and death and Hades gave up the dead which were in them; and they were judged, every one of them according to their deeds. 14 And death and Hades were thrown into the lake of fire. This is the second death, the lake of fire. 15 And **if anyone's name was not found written in the book of life**, he was thrown into the lake of fire."

There are eternal consequences to how believers respond to God's saving grace.


### 2 Corinthians 5:10


"For we must all appear before the **judgment seat of Christ**, that each one may be recompensed for his deeds."



### John 3

## 1 John 1

"<sup>5</sup> This is the message we have heard from him and announce to you, that God is light, and in Him there is no darkness at all. <sup>6</sup> If we say that we have fellowship with Him and yet walk in the darkness, we lie and do not practice the truth; <sup>7</sup> but if we walk in the light as He Himself is in the light, we have fellowship with one another, and the blood of Jesus His Son cleanses us from all sin. <sup>8</sup> If we say that we have no sin, we are deceiving ourselves and the truth is not in us. <sup>9</sup> If we confess our sins, he is faithful and righteous to forgive us our sins and to cleanse us from all unrighteousness."

"Practice the truth" does not mean that we have no sin but rather that we see more than our sin as we face the light (Jesus).

# Both Peter & Judas betrayed Jesus and suffered remorse as they saw what their sin did to Jesus.

### Peter would abide long enough to see what Jesus did to his sin.

Judas took his own life and never saw what Jesus did to his sin.

If we don't let our sins draw us to Jesus, we are left alone in them.
