- 1. We view it as a feeling.
- 2. We treat it as a minor issue of the faith.
- 3. We fail to see its evangelistic power.
- 4. We don't offer it to the "deplorables".
- 5. We emphasize it as an initiative in life.
- 6. We apply it primarily at a distance.
- 7. We feel like we don't know how to do it.

1. View agape love as a choice (not a feeling).


Hebrews 12:2

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Love a major someone's soul with a commitment to sacrificially help them reach the deepest desire of their heart, which is peace with God, self, & others.

3. Recognize that agape love is our evangelistic message to the world.

John 17:23

"I in them, and Thou in Me, that they may be perfected in unity, that the world may know that Thou didst send Me, and didst love them, even as Thou didst love Me."

The Way of the Cross points back to the Word of the Cross

 NOTE: God's love is unconditional (in spite of the internal & external circumstances.





4. Pay special attention to the "least" among us.




7. When you don't know what to do - Show up, listen, and PRAY.


Ephesians 3


