Is God there?


Does God care?

Could it be that the Biblical answer -"EASTER" is clear but unpopular?

Why is CHRISTMAS more popular than EASTER?

The Word of the Cross (salvation) is more popular than

the Way of the Cross (sacrifice)

Easter reminds us that:



- 1. our hope is not in this life, and
- 2. we must die to experience it.

John 17 (Jesus' prayer for his followers)

"23 . . . that they may be perfected in unity, that the world may know that Thou didst send Me, and didst love them, even as Thou didst love Me. . . . 26 that the love wherewith Thou didst love Me may be in them, and I in them."



Are we prepared for this kind of love?

1 John 4

"7 Beloved, let us love one another, for love is from God; and everyone who loves is born of God and knows God. 8 The one who does not love does not know God, for God is love."

What is this thing called **AGAPE love?**

1. AGAPE love is a CHOICE.

- It is NOT something we

"fall into" or "out of".

- It is a command in both the Old and New Testaments.

Matthew 22 (Deut. 6:5, Lev. 19:18)

"37 And He said to him, 'You shall love the Lord your God with all your heart, and with all your soul, and with all your mind.' 38 This is the great and foremost commandment. 39 The second is like it. 'You shall love your neighbor as yourself.' 40 On these two commandments depend the whole Law and the Prophets."

 It is a command in both the Old and New Testaments.

- It springs from that we receive at hirth

- It is awakened by the image of God the Spirit of Christ that we receive at new birth.

- It is the heart of God's nature and kingdom on earth. and his disciples.

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- It is modeled by the life of Jesus

Agape love is a credential.

- It IDs us as Christians.
- It assures us of union with Christ.
- It authenticates our witness to the Gospel.


John 13:35

"By this all men will know that you are my disciples, if you have love for one another."

Note what IS NOT mentioned personal piety, world evangelism, cultural triumphalism, social peace & justice.

1 John 3:24

"And the one who keeps His commandments abides in Him, and He in him. And we know by this that He abides in us, by the Spirit whom He has given us."



When I choose to love as Jesus did, I indicate that I am abiding in him and his Spirit is abiding in me.



Love does not merit our salvation but is the fruit of it.




1 John 4




2. AGAPE love is a SACRIFICE.


Agape love is MANIFESTED through Christ's sacrifice and ours.

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The great symbols of the faith ARE



The Cross The Lord's Supper

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Baptism

reminding us of the death and resurrection of Jesus.

1 John 4

"12 No one has beheld God at any time; if we love one another, God abides in us, and His love is perfected in us. 13 By this we know that we abide in Him and He in us, because He has given us of His Spirit. 14 And we have beheld and **bear witness** that the Father has sent the Son to be the Savior of the world."

3. AGAPE love is a WITNESS.

- TO us and THROUGH us to others.

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How can we nurture agape love?

- We need to be reminded weekly of the Word & Way of the Cross.
- We need to reinforce the Way of the Cross by modeling it.
- We need to resist the temptation to let the world define our hope.
- We must respond to a broken world as a ministry opportunity.

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1 Corinthians 15

"17 and if Christ has not been raised, your faith is worthless; you are still in your sins. 18 Then those also who have fallen asleep in Christ have perished. 19 If we have hoped in Christ in this life only, we are of all men most to be pitied."

How did Paul understand this life's troubling circumstances



in the context of God's love?

Paul viewed life in an **EASTER** context.

Romans 8

"18 For I consider that the **sufferings** of this present time are not worthy to be compared with the glory that is to be revealed to us. . . 35 Who shall separate us from the love of Christ? Shall **tribulation**, or **distress**, or **persecution**, or **famine**, or **nakedness**, or **peril**, or **sword**? 36 Just as it is written, "For Thy sake we are being put to death all day long; we were **considered as sheep** to be slaughtered." . . . 39 no created thing, shall be able to separate us from the love of God, which is in Christ Jesus our Lord."

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Paul embraced the WAY of the Cross.

1 Corinthians 4

"10 We are **fools for Christ's sake**, but you are prudent in Christ; we are **weak**, but you are strong; you are distinguished, but we are **without honor.** 11 To this present hour we are both **hungry and thirsty**, and are **poorly clothed**, and are **roughly treated**, and are **homeless**; 12 and we **toil, working with our own hands**; when we are **reviled**, we bless; when we are **persecuted**, we endure; 13 when we are **slandered**, we try to conciliate; we have become **as the scum of the world**, the **dregs of all things**, even until now."



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
