





Are we numbered among "some of those" who are walking in it?


Does "it" mean "truth"?


Affirming the authority of Scripture Respecting the righteousness of God Defending the dignity of human life.


Or does "it" mean "love"?

3. Fight the right battles.

Ephesians 6:12

• It's not "them" or only the demons in them but the temptation in us - Reflect on the temptation of Jesus in Matt.4:1-11.

Matthew 4

(prosperity?)

"3 **Command** that these stones become bread."

(protection?)

6 He will command His angels concerning you so that you will not strike your foot against a stone."

(power?)

9 All these things I will give you, if you (prostrate yourself before) me."

The temptation is to live with the expectations of O.C. shalom (this world's peace).

Zechariah 4:6


"Not by might nor by power, but by My Spirit says the Lord of hosts.

Isaiah 30

"1 Woe to the rebellious children," declares the Lord, "Who execute a plan, but not Mine, and make an alliance, but not of My Spirit, in order to add sin to sin; 2 Who proceed down to Egypt without consulting Me, to take refuge in the safety of Pharaoh, and to seek shelter in the shadow of Egypt! 3 Therefore the safety of Pharaoh will be your shame, and the shelter in the shadow of Egypt, your humiliation."

Why did sinners listen to Jesus?

He was a "friend of sinners".

- the woman at the well
- washing feet not lording it over.
- hanging out in Galilee (low rent district).

He listened and asked questions.

- seeking and addressing root needs.
- the adulterous before the Pharisees. Jn.8

He sacrificially served the cry of the poor.

 It's hard to argue with those who take time and personally sacrifice to love us.

Jesus' example and style

- He walked beside sinners.
- He sought to understand.
- · He asked questions & listened.
- He addressed the root issues.
- He walked the WAY OF THE CROSS.
