- · Feeling alone, confused, left out, over looked, beaten down, without hope.




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## If Jesus is the "Good Shepherd" why are the sheep suffering so?

The problem may be in the context of our application.

"All Scripture is written FOR us but not necessarily TO us or ABOUT us."



#### Jude

"4 For certain persons have crept in unnoticed, those who were long beforehand marked out for this condemnation, ungodly persons who turn the grace of our God into licentiousness and deny our only Master and Lord, Jesus Christ."

> Ungodly messengers among the sheep misunderstand the Word of the Cross and the Way of the Cross.



#### 2 Peter 2

"14 Therefore, beloved, since you look for these things, be diligent to be found by Him in peace, spotless and blameless, 15 and regard the patience of our Lord as salvation; just as also our beloved brother Paul, according to the wisdom given him, wrote to you, 16 as also in all his letters, speaking in them of these things, in which are some things hard to understand, which the untaught and unstable distort, as they do also the rest of the Scriptures, to their own destruction."

Many had separated the WORD of the Cross (Christ's death FOR us) from the WAY of the Cross (Christ's life IN and THROUGH us).

#### Romans 6

"1 What shall we say then? Are we to continue in sin that grace might increase?
2 May it never be! How shall we who died to sin still live in it?"

# This question confirms Paul's teaching of God's radical grace in Christ.

- √ The question makes sense only if Paul's teaching of radical freedom from the condemnation of the Law is his intention.
- ✓ Note what he is NOT saying in response. "You have misunderstood me." "You can't remove the condemnation of the Law from the Christian life. You are still under the Law."
- √ Note what he will say. "Your new identity frees you from fear and calls you to freedom from sin's lie, that it will bring you life."

Abundant in faith!


