"5 Now I desire to **remind** you, though you know all things once for all,"

- The Shepherd does not address the wolf until He has prepared the sheep.
- The sheep need to know the message and model of the wolves (false teachers).
- It is assumed that Jude's readers may already know this but need to be repeatedly reminded of it.

Three false messages that we need to resist.

3

1. A false HOPE in this world.

"5 . . . that the Lord, after saving a people out of the land of Egypt, subsequently destroyed those who did not believe."

- We should learn from observations of others so that we don't have to learn from personal experience.
- · God's hand is seen in both saving, and destroying.
- The "Good Shepherd's" heart is directed to our response to life's challenges.
- Our "faith" response to what God has done will determine our relationship to what God will do.

God's gifts can become our idols.



2. A foreign HOME in this world.

"6 And angels who did not keep their own domain, but abandoned their proper abode, He has kept in eternal bonds under darkness for the judgment of the great day,"

- · Our proper domain is defined by our baptism.
- · Where do we seek to find comfort?
- · Where are we investing our lives?

NOTE: The background of this text is taken from the book of Enoch as though it was "Scripture".

I Corinthians 14

"20 Brethren, do not be children in your thinking; yet in evil be babes, but in your thinking be mature. 21 In the Law it is written, "By men of strange tongues and by the lips of strangers I will speak to this people, and even so they will not listen to Me," says the Lord. 22 So then tongues are for a sign, not to those who believe, but to unbelievers; but prophecy is for a sign, not to unbelievers, but to those who believe."

"Tongues" were a sign to unbelieving Jews in exile, under God's discipline. Isa.28:11-12

3. A foul HABITAT in this world.

"7 just as Sodom and Gomorrah and the cities around them, since they in the same way as these indulged in gross immorality and went after strange flesh, are exhibited as an example in undergoing the punishment of eternal fire."

- Sodom and Gomorrah reflected their environment.
- Only a remnant (Lot) was not integrated into the worldly domain's debauchery.
- Adopting the values of this fallen world, and temporal age is a ticket to harsh judgment.

Romans 1

"18 For the wrath of God is revealed from heaven against all ungodliness and unrighteousness of men, who suppress the truth in unrighteousness, . . . 25 For they exchanged the truth of God for a lie, and worshiped and served the creature rather than the Creator,"

"28 And just as they did not see fit to acknowledge God any longer, God gave them over to a depraved mind, to do those things which are not proper,"

"3:9 Are we better than they? Not at all; for we have already charged that both Jews and Greeks are all under sin;"


