
## **HYPOCRISY**

As Spiritual Aliens in a Hostile World we face pressure to either:

Change the world
Conform to the world
Check out of the world



In each of these cases we are in danger of losing THE FAITH.



We need wise guidance knowing that Satan is not after OUR FAITH but rather it's object, THE FAITH.

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#### John 14

"25 These things I have spoken to you, while abiding with you. 26 But the Helper, the Holy Spirit, whom the Father will send in My name, He will teach you all things, and bring to your remembrance all that I said to you."

### John 16:13

"But when He, the Spirit of truth, comes, He will guide you into all the truth; . . . and He will disclose to you what is to come."

This is Jesus' endorsement of apostles' teaching.

## But what do the Apostles teach?

### Jude 20-23

"20 But you, beloved, **building yourselves** up on your most holy faith; praying in the Holy Spirit; 21 **keep yourselves** in the love of God,

**waiting anxiously** for the mercy of our Lord Jesus Christ to eternal life.

22 And **have mercy** on some, who are doubting; 23 save others, snatching them out of the fire; and on some have mercy **with fear**, hating even the garment polluted by the flesh."

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### Jude 20-23 (paraphrase)

### Double down on the Word of the Cross.

"20 The grace of God is something you know very well, so keep nurturing it in yourselves as you commune with God through the gift of His Spirit. 21 Keep the grace of God foremost in your mind as you eagerly look forward to heaven.

### Follow through with the Way of the Cross.

22 But don't just soak up God's grace for yourself. Show it toward those who are confused by false teaching. 23 Rescue those who have fallen away, but be wise in showing grace lest you compromise the full truth of the Gospel."

## Paul's "Great Commission"

#### Romans 12

"1 I urge you therefore, brethren, **by the mercies of God**, to present your bodies a living and holy sacrifice, acceptable to God, which is your spiritual service of worship.

2 And do not be conformed to this world, but be transformed by the renewing of your mind, that you may prove what the will of God is, that which is good and acceptable and perfect."

### Ephesians 4

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# Goal #1 - Be transformed (to the image of God)

- Unity Bring believers together. (solidarity with the majors and gracious with the minors of the faith)
- 2. Maturity Bring believers to adulthood. (secure, strong, and steadfast)
- 3. Fullness Bring believers to full humanity. (an integrated life)

# What does God's Image (spiritual "salt and light") look like?

# Goal #2 - Be not conformed (to the values of this world)

- 1. Stability Bring believers to stability. (remaining faithful and yet flexible)
- 2. Security Resisting seductive teaching. (fads, trends, political correctness, etc.)
- 3. Scrutiny Discerning deceitful sources. (recognizing those who lead others astray)

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"15 but speaking the truth in love, we are to grow up in all aspects into Him, who is the head, even Christ, 16 from whom the whole body, being fitted and held together by that which every joint supplies, according to the proper working of each individual part, causes the growth of the body for the building up of itself in love."

# Means - common tools & individual roles

- Tools Use words and attitude to shape lives. (integrated Christ likeness)
- 2. Participation Everyone needs to show up. (It takes a community to build a disciple.)
- Propriety Focus on your part. (respect the different roles of others)

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# As Bereans, note what you will not hear the Apostles teach:

### Jesus and the Apostles do not try to:

- 1. transform the worldly environment.
- 2. remove God's sheep from the worldly environment.
- 3. sugarcoat the cost of discipleship in a worldly environment.
- 4. give hope that the world will change before Christ returns.
- 5. anoint things that are bad and call them good.

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# Walking in a manner worthy of our calling.

- 1. We are commanded to build the Body of Christ (the church) to maturity (Godliness).
- 2. The way we relate to one another in the community of faith is paramount.
- 3. The way we relate to the outside world is a show and tell ministry of faith, hope, and love through us by God's Spirit.
- 4. A big part of being salt and light is in how we respond to life's ups and downs.

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# Some "sacred cows" that may reflect our world more than God's kingdom.

- Christian Nationalism We should promote kingdom values over individualism, tribalism, nationalism, etc.
- 2. Competitive spirit Competition without cooperation, and compassion is carnal.
- 3. Narrow vision We should seek a broader & longer perspective.
- Optics & pragmatics We should address the inner person not just outward appearances.
