Apostolic teaching is the foundation of the FAITH.



2 Peter 1

"16 For we did not follow cleverly devised tales when we made known to you the power and coming of our Lord Jesus Christ, but we were eyewitnesses of His majesty. 17 For when He received honor and glory from God the Father, such a declaration as this was made to Him by the Majestic Glory: "This is My beloved Son with whom I am well pleased" — 18 and we ourselves heard this declaration made from heaven when we were with Him on the holy mountain."

The author of 2 Peter: claimed to be an eyewitness to the majesty of Christ.

"19 And so we have the prophetic word made more sure, to which you do well to pay attention as to a lamp shining in a dark place, until the day dawns and the morning star arises in your hearts. 20 But know this first of all, that no prophecy of Scripture becomes a matter of someone's own interpretation, 21 for no prophecy was ever made by an act of human will, but men moved by the Holy Spirit spoke from God."

2 Peter 1

The message of the Scriptures that enlightened the heart of man did not originate from the mind of man but from God.



Many books claimed to be written by Peter but were rejected as pseudepigrapha


> Apocalypse of Peter, Preaching of Peter, Gospel of Peter. Acts of Peter

















The Word and Way of the Cross is the Apostolic Message.

1 Corinthians 1






Paul's Gospel is centered in the death and resurrection of Christ.

1 Corinthians 15

"1 Now I make known to you, brethren, **the gospel which I preached to you**, which also you received, in which also you stand, 2 by which also you are saved, if you hold fast the word which I preached to you, unless you believed in vain. 3 For I delivered to you as of **first importance** what I also received, that Christ **died** for our sins according to the Scriptures, 4 and that He was buried, and that He was **raised** on the third day according to the Scriptures,"


