

# A case for the "Top Down" Theory Look at what the Bible says about itself:

Every scripture is inspired by God and useful for teaching, for reproof, for correction, and for training in righteousness (II Timothy 3:16 - NET)

No prophecy was ever borne of human impulse; rather, men carried along by the Holy Spirit spoke from God. (2 Peter 1:21 - NET)




Did God leave us an objective test for inspiration?

27% of the Bible is predictive prophecy!

No other "sacred book" has more than 1%

- 1. Since over ¼ of the Bible was predictive prophecy at its writing, and
- 2. Since events were predicted well before the fact (sometimes centuries), and
- 3. Since it is highly improbable if not impossible for man to know the future with such accuracy,
- 4. Then, the best conclusion is that an infinite God, who sees all of time at once, revealed the future events to finite man who recorded them.


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


