
What does it mean?

Today's Definition of "Euthanasia"


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IT IS ASSISTED SUICIDE






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- Non-voluntary--patient incabable of making a voluntary request to die.



Active euthanasia is usually an act of commission causing the death of another.


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"Right to die" supported by both sides as a Constitutional right to privacy. (Quinlan 1976)



Mercy killing is to kill a patient usually by injection of lethal drugs. (Kevorkian)


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Other Euphemisms "physician assisted dying", "compassionate dying", "natural death", "quality of life", "end-of-life choice".



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
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History

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
Hippocratic Oath: "I will prescribe regimens for the good of my patients according to my ability and my judgment and never do harm to anyone. I will give no deadly medicine to any one if asked, nor suggest any such counsel; and similarly I will not give a woman a pessary to cause an abortion."

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


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- God is sovereign over life and death.

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- Death is a spiritual event with biological consequences.
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
