Paul Explains Why

¹⁷For Christ did not send me to baptize, but to preach the gospel—not with wisdom and eloquence,





lest the cross of Christ be emptied of its power.

¹⁸The Message of the Cross

is foolishness to those who are perishing, but to us who are being saved it is the power of God. ¹⁹For it is written:

"I will destroy the wisdom of the wise; the intelligence of the intelligent I will frustrate." ²⁰Where is the wise person? Where is the teacher of the law? Where is the philosopher of this age? Has not God made foolish the wisdom of the world? ²¹For since in the *wisdom* of God the world through its wisdom did not know him, God was pleased through the foolishness of what was preached to save those who believe. 1. To Be Fair

²⁶Brothers and sisters, think of what you were when you were called.

1a. Not many of you were wise by human standards. (So if we came to Christ by wisdom, it wouldn't be fair.)

1b. Not many were influential; not many were of noble birth. (So if we came by power, it wouldn't be fair.)

2. God Chose

- ²⁷The weak things of ²⁷The foolish things of the world to shame the world to shame the strong.
- ²⁸God chose the lowly
- things of this world and the despised things and the things that are not—to nullify things that are,



²⁹So that no one may boast before him!



³⁰It is because of him that you are in Christ Jesus, who has become for us *wisdom* from God—that is, our righteousness, holiness and redemption.



³¹Therefore, as it is written, "Let the one who boasts boast in the Lord."
