
> **Expectations Commitments**

James 1 "22 But prove yourselves doers of the word, and not merely hearers who delude themselves.

The Word transforms our lives but only when applied.

23 For if anyone is a hearer of the word and not a doer, he is like a man who looks at his natural face in a mirror; 24 for once he has looked at himself and gone away, he has immediately forgotten what kind of person he was. 25 But one who looks intently at the perfect law, the **law of liberty**, and abides by it, not having become a forgetful hearer but an effectual doer, this man will be blessed in what he does."

Application of the Word starts with what it says about who we are in Christ.

in response to circumstances.



The Word of the Cross challenges us to see ourselves "in Christ".

2 Corinthians 5

"16 Therefore from now on we recognize no man according to the flesh; . . . 17 Therefore if any man is in Christ, he is a new creature; the old things passed away; behold, new things have come. 18 Now all these things are from God, who reconciled us to Himself through Christ, and gave us the ministry of reconciliation, 19 namely, that God was in Christ reconciling the world to Himself, not counting their trespasses against them, and He has committed to us the word of reconciliation."

- Bible = a confusing encyclopedia of "proof texts" that don't agree.


"Is saving faith inseparable **Example:** from keeping the Law?"

The Way of the Cross

is the declaration of man's reconciliation with God by faith apart from works. is the calling to live sacrificially in being a blessing more than seeking one.






Not all who embrace the Word of the Cross exemplify the Way of the Cross.

Don't confuse the ministries of the Law, the Son, and the Spirit.

Philippians 3:10

Luke 18

"9 And He also told this parable to certain ones who trusted in themselves that they were righteous, and viewed others with contempt: 10 Two men went up into the temple to pray, one a Pharisee, and the other a tax-gatherer. 11 The **Pharisee** stood and was praying thus to himself, 'God, I thank Thee that I am not like other people: swindlers, unjust, adulterers, or even like this taxgatherer. 12 I fast twice a week; I pay tithes of all that I get.' 13 But the tax-gatherer, standing some distance away, was even unwilling to lift up his eyes to heaven, but was beating his breast, saying, 'God, be merciful to me, the sinner!' 14 I tell you, this man went down to his house justified rather than the other; for everyone who exalts himself shall be humbled, but he who humbles himself shall be exalted."




Defend our image
