




Many (whites)

that is negative.


Many (blacks)

that is negative.




Both tend to disengage from listening and engage with anger.


#### Matthew 25:14-30 (parable of the Talents)

31 If the righteous will be rewarded in the earth, how much more the wicked and the sinner (get theirs)!" 20



#### John 15

### What is abiding faith?


- It's not like buying a ticket for a bus that you ride.

- ★ It bears fruit on its own if it is maintained.


#### Luke 6


