

1 Peter 1

"13 Therefore, prepare your minds for action, keep sober in spirit, fix your hope completely on the grace to be brought to you at the revelation of Jesus Christ. 14 As obedient children, do not be conformed to the former lusts which were yours in your ignorance, 15 but **like the Holy One who called you, be holy yourselves** also in all your behavior; 16 because it is written, "**You shall be holy, for I am holy.**""

Mark 7

" 5 And the Pharisees and the scribes asked Him, "Why do Your disciples not walk according to the tradition of the elders, but eat their bread with impure hands?" 6 And He said to them, "Rightly did Isaiah prophesy of you hypocrites, as it is written, 'This people honors Me with their lips, But their heart is far away from Me. 7 But in vain do they worship Me, Teaching as doctrines the precepts of men.' 8 Neglecting the commandment of God, you hold to the tradition of men.""

"14 After He called the crowd to Him again, He began saying to them, "Listen to Me, all of you, and understand: 15 there is nothing outside the man which going into him can defile him; but the things which proceed out of the man are what defile the man. 16 If any man has ears to hear, let him hear." 17 When he had left the crowd and entered the house, His disciples questioned Him about the **parable**."

The defilement that we fear comes not from external contacts but from the condition of our heart.

"18 And He said to them, "Are you so lacking in understanding also? Do you not understand that whatever goes into the man from outside cannot defile him; 19 because it does not go into his heart, but into his stomach, and is eliminated?" (Thus He declared all foods clean.) 20 And He was saying, "That which proceeds out of the man, that is what defiles the man. 21 For from within, out of the heart of men, proceed the evil thoughts, fornications, thefts, murders, adulteries, 22 deeds of coveting and wickedness, as well as deceit, sensuality, envy, slander, pride and foolishness. 23 All these evil things proceed from within and defile the man."" 12

Colossians 2


"20 If you have died with Christ to the elementary principles of the world, why, as if you were living in the world, do you submit yourself to decrees, such as, 21 "**Do not handle, do not taste, do not touch**!" 22 (which all refer to things destined to perish with the using) — in accordance with the commandments and teachings of men? 23 These are matters which have, to be sure, the appearance of wisdom in self-made religion and selfabasement and severe treatment of the body, but are of no value against fleshly indulgence."


Paul explains (interprets & applies) the O.C. Law through the lens of the N.C.

This differed from the way many Jewish traditions applied it.

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We interpret the Scriptures through lenses.






1 Corinthians 10

"23 All things are lawful, but not all things are profitable. All things are lawful, but not all things edify. 24 Let no one seek his own good, but that of his neighbor. 25 Eat anything that is sold in the meat market, without asking questions for conscience' sake; 26 for the earth is the Lord's, and all it contains. 27 If one of the unbelievers invites you, and you wish to go, eat anything that is set before you, without asking questions for conscience' sake. 28 But if anyone should say to you, "This is meat sacrificed to idols," do not eat it, for the sake of the one who informed you, and for conscience' sake; 29 I mean not your own conscience, but the other man's; for why is my freedom judged by another's conscience?"

Defilement comes not from the meat but from insensitivity to another person's welfare.

Exorcism is not emphasized in the Apostle's teaching to the early church.

References to exorcism in the New Testament



John 17

"15 I do not ask You to take them out of the world, but to keep them from the evil *one*. 16 **They are not of the world**, even as I am not of the world. 17 Sanctify them in the truth; Your word is truth. 18 As You sent Me into the world, **I also have sent them into the world**. 19 For their sakes I sanctify Myself, that they themselves also may be sanctified in truth. 20 "I do not ask on behalf of these alone, but for those also who believe in Me through their word;"

Holiness calls us to be in the world but not of the world.


"Alien Ambassadors"

This is the emphasis in the early church.

Romans 12

"1 I urge you therefore, brethren, by the mercies of God, to present your bodies a living and **holy** sacrifice, acceptable to God, which is your spiritual service of worship. 2 And **do not be conformed to this world**, but be transformed by the renewing of your mind, that you may prove what the will of God is, that which is good and acceptable and perfect."

Paul is talking about "DEFILEMENT" here.

2. Sacrifice is our offering

- "present" We must lay aside (sacrifice) our personal physical comforts to be "salt and light"
- "living and holy sacrifice" a part of us (our old self) must die if we are to escape defilement.

Test question What have we willingly sacrificed to be a disciple of Christ? "2 And do not be conformed to this world,"

3. Attachment is our agenda

• "conformed to this world" - Don't be a disciple of the spirit of this age and world.

Test question How have we responded when we lost

something of this world that we valued?

Worldliness is not just behavior but rather a way of thinking, seeing, longing, and working for things the world can give and take away.
