

- "2 And during supper, the devil having already put into the heart of Judas Iscariot, the son of Simon, to betray Him, 3 Jesus, knowing that the Father had given all things into His hands, and that He had come forth from God, and was going back to God, 4 rose from supper, and laid aside His garments; and taking a towel, He girded Himself about. 5 Then He poured water into the basin, and began to wash the disciples' feet, and to wipe them with the towel with which He was girded."
- This took place at the time of the Last Supper.
- · Luke 22:24 tells us that the 12 were arguing as to who would be the greatest in the Kingdom.
- Jesus was fully aware of his authority, the betrayal of Judas, and the denial of Peter that was to come.



A love attachment forgets about self.

"6 And so He came to Simon Peter. He said to Him, "Lord, do You wash my feet?" 7 Jesus answered and said to him, "What I do you do not realize now, but you shall understand hereafter." 8 Peter said to Him, "Never shall You wash my feet!" Jesus answered him, "If I do not wash you, you have no part with Me.""

 Peter was prepared to worship Jesus as Lord, but not to understand or follow him as Suffering Servant.

"12 And so when He had washed their feet, and taken His garments, and reclined at the table again, He said to them, "Do you know what I have done to you? 13 You call Me Teacher and Lord; and you are right, for so I am. 14 If I then, the Lord and the Teacher, washed your feet, you also ought to wash one another's feet. 15 For I gave you an example that you also should do as I did to you. 16 Truly, truly, I say to you, a slave is not greater than his master; neither is one who is sent greater than the one who sent him."

 Humble service of one another is not below our Lord and should not be below us.



It starts with an attitude

Philippians 2

- "3 Do nothing from selfishness or empty conceit, but with humility of mind let each of you regard one another as more important than himself; 4 do not merely look out for your own personal interests, but also for the interests of others.
- 5 Have this attitude in yourselves which was also in Christ Jesus, 6 who, although He existed in the form of God, did not regard equality with God a thing to be grasped, 7 but emptied Himself, taking the form of a bondservant, and being made in the likeness of men. 8 And being found in appearance as a man, He humbled Himself by becoming obedient to the point of death, even death on a cross."



"17 If you know these things, you are blessed if you do them."

- Personal edification comes through self sacrifice in service.
- What goes around, comes around.

Attachment is a two way street.

Observations

- · Our role in this life is not to reign with Christ but to suffer & serve with him.
- This is a mutual (one another) activity.
- Knowing this is of little value until it results in action.
- Service in little things is a big deal.
- We have no part with Jesus if we fail to learn this.

Four challenges to church culture

- 1. The ministers minister and the congregation congregates.
- 2. Leaders are entitled, and / or exempt.
- 3. We talk the talk without walking the walk.
- 4. Like Peter, we too often see Christ as an object of worship but not as an example to be followed.

Why we resist this teaching.

- **1. It sounds too much like socialism.** "God helps those who help themselves".
- 2. The church should be "reaching out" rather than "pampering itself".
- 3. This is a low priority in light of other needs.
- 4. I don't profit from being least or last.
- 5. I'm called to reign with Christ.
- 6. It makes us vulnerable.
