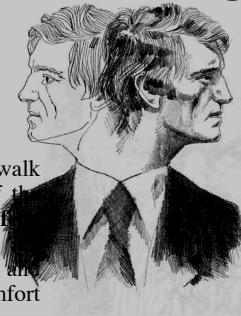
Where do I find life?

Psalm 23:4

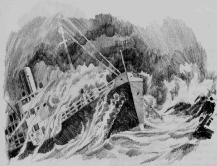
How do I manage fear?
