




#### Satan's sneaky pack of lies

- ✓ A toxic church culture that is narcissistic, pragmatic, and punitive.

1. Lower the expectations - Psychotherapy.



#### Romans 7




"7 What shall we say then? Is the Law sin? May it never be!"

# The two sides of "self" Shame is our ego's punishment for "failure" Pride is our ego's reward for "success"





- ✓ Can Matt.22:37-39 be satisfied? "love your God with *all* your heart, soul, and mind"
- ✓ Is freedom from "know" sin enough? "I am conscious of nothing against myself, yet I am *not* by this acquitted . . ." 1 Cor.4:4
- ✓ Does "perfect" (Greek) = flawless or complete?
- ✓ Is the "flesh" still present? "The flesh sets its desire against the Spirit, and the Spirit against the flesh; for these are in opposition to one another, so that you may not do the things that you please." Gal. 5:17

- ✓ Can anyone claim to be perfect?
