Titus 2

"11 For the grace of God has appeared, bringing salvation to all men, 12 instructing us to deny ungodliness and worldly desires and to live sensibly, righteously and godly in the present age, 13 looking for the **blessed hope** and the appearing of the glory of our great God and Savior, Christ Jesus;"

Why is the 2nd coming of Christ a blessed hope?

- 1. Our hope is not centered in this world.
- 2. Our sense of fulfillment and meaning rest in God's Kingdom, not in this fallen and evil age.
- 3. We must resist the temptation to seek fulfillment of our soul's deepest longings in this world.
- 4. The essence of being fully human is to live so as to find life in the Christ and his Kingdom.
- 5. Sin can be defined as a life of attitudes and behaviors that seek human fulfillment apart from trusting and obeying God as He is revealed in Christ and his Kingdom.


Considerations in interpreting Biblical Prophecy

- 1. Historically, the proper understanding of O.T. prophecies was only after their fulfillment.
- 2. The track record of interpreters of as yet unfulfilled prophecy has been less than impressive.
- 3. The church has not been of one mind with respect to the interpretation of Biblical prophecies.
- 4. For these reasons, I am not dogmatic about interpretation of yet unfulfilled Biblical prophecies.
- 5. I have more confidence in the Apostles' reading of the prophecies than I do of my reading of them.

2 Peter 1:19

"So we have the prophetic word made more sure, to which you do well to pay attention as to a lamp shining in a dark place until the day dawns and the morning star arises in your hearts."

- 1. Prophecy is like a lamp giving dim light enabling limited sight.
- 2. The fulfillment is like the sunrise enabling clear sight.
- 3. The morning star (Christ Rev.22:16) in our hearts suggests a correlation between clear sight and a faith relationship with Christ.



1 Corinthians 15

"22 For as in Adam all die, even so in Christ shall all be made alive. 23 But every man in his own order: Christ the first-fruits; **afterward they that are Christ's at his coming**. 24 Then cometh the end, when he shall have delivered up the kingdom to God, even the Father; when he shall have put down all rule and all authority and power. 25 For he must reign, till he hath put all enemies under his feet. The last enemy that shall be destroyed is death."

The 2nd Coming of Christ will trigger:

- a. The resurrection of the dead believers.
- b. This will be followed by "the end" the culmination of Christ's reign and victory over death.

2 Peter 3

"10 But the day of the Lord will come like a thief, in which the heavens will pass away with a roar and the elements will be destroyed with intense heat, and the earth and its works will be burned up. 11 Since all these things are to be destroyed in this way what sort of people ought you to be in holy conduct and godliness, 12 looking for and hastening the coming of the day of God, because of which the heavens will be destroyed by burning, and the elements will melt with intense heat! 13 But according to His promise we are looking for new heavens and a new earth, in which righteousness dwells."

The 2nd Coming of Christ will:

a. Be a surprise.

b. Result in destruction of this world.

c. Followed by a new heavens and earth.

1 Thessalonians 4

"15 For this we say to you by the word of the Lord, that we who are alive and remain until the coming of the Lord, will not precede those who have fallen asleep. 16 For the Lord Himself will descend from heaven with a shout, with the voice of the archangel, and with the trumpet of God; and the dead in Christ shall rise first. 17 Then we who are alive and remain shall be caught up together with them in the clouds to meet the Lord in the air, and thus we shall always be with the Lord. 18 Therefore comfort one another with these words."

The 2nd Coming of Christ will trigger: a. The resurrection of the dead believers. b. The rapture of the living believers.

1 Thessalonians 5

"1 Now as to the times and the epochs, brethren, you have no need of anything to be written to you. 2 For you yourselves know full well that the day of the Lord will come just like a thief in the night. 3 While they are saying, "Peace and safety!" then destruction will come upon them suddenly like birth pangs upon a woman with child; and they shall not escape. 4 But you, brethren, are not in darkness, that the day should overtake you like a thief; . . . 9 For God has not destined us for wrath, but for obtaining salvation through our Lord Jesus Christ, 10 who died for us, that whether we are awake or asleep, we may live together with Him. 11 Therefore encourage one another, and build up one another, just as you also are doing."

The 2nd Coming of Christ:


- a. Will surprise the world in its false security.
- b. Should not surprise believers who will escape God's judgment.


Matthew 24

The 2nd coming of Christ -Practical considerations

- 1. History is linear it is progressing to a planned end.
- 2. It will be the time of the resurrection of the dead. We cannot expect our union with Christ to be complete until then.
- 3. It will be the time of the fullness of His Kingdom. We cannot expect the Kingdom's fullness until Christ comes.
- 4. It will be the time of the fulfillment of God's promise to the nation Israel. Israel does not have special rights over the land until then.
- 5. It will be the time of judgment. We are to be watchful.
