

can delight our souls, direct our behavior, and shape our community


but also lead to anxiety.



"For My people have committed two evils; they have forsaken Me, the fountain of living waters, to hew for themselves cisterns, broken cisterns that can hold no water."








1. Follow a hireling shepherd.

The problem is not our lack of faith.


It is that our faith is in something other than God and / or for something other than His kingdom.


God's plan is less concerned about my temporal comfort and social image
