



- 1) the nature of our expectations
- 2) the breadth of our perspective.
- 3) the ordering of our priorities.



# The greatest hindrances to making peace are:

- √ Failure to MANAGE your own anger and anxiety.
- √ Failure to see conflict as an OPPORTUNITY for being a peacemaker.
- √ Failure to ADDRESS the root of conflict.
- ✓ Failure to LISTEN to all sides of a conflict.
- √ Failure to have CONFIDENCE in the Gospel of grace in the Cross of Christ.
