



Consider

- ✓ The Apostles' teaching, focus on the cross and resurrection (not the ethics and miracles of Jesus).
- ✓ The good news that is preached to the world is Reconciliation with God (not ethical renewal).
- ✓ The principle symbol of the faith is the cross (not the dove or a towel).
