

How to read the Old Testament




Hebrews 2

"14 Therefore, since the children share in flesh and blood, He (**Jesus**) himself likewise also partook of the same, that through death he might render powerless him who had the power of death, that is, the devil; 15 and might deliver those who **through fear of death were subject to slavery all their lives**."


What is the fear of death?

the concern we all have of missing out on things that we believe we need to live a significant, full, and happy life.


Does God expect too much and provide too little?



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Romans 8

"15 For you have not received a spirit of slavery leading to fear again, but you have received a spirit of adoption as sons by which we cry out, "Abba! Father!" ¹⁶ The Spirit Himself bears witness with our spirit that we are children of God, 17 and if children, heirs also, heirs of God and fellow heirs with Christ,"

> The O.C. Law tied acceptance to obedience. (thus "slavery" and "fear")

The N.C. was not to reactivate or double down on O.C. fear (insecurity)? 11

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Jesus clarified the Law's demands.

Matthew 5:20

"For I say to you, that unless your righteousness surpasses that of the scribes and Pharisees, you shall not enter the kingdom of heaven.""

The Law simply demanded that we be true to ourselves in bearing the image of God.

But for "fallen humanity" this would be impossible.

- ➡ The Sermon on the Mount is full of warnings about failing to fulfill the spirit of the Law. "whoever shall say 'you fool' shall be guilty enough to go into the hell of fire." (Matt.5:22-23).
- ➡ Matt.5:29-30 "And if your right eye makes you stumble, tear it out, and throw it from you; for it is better for you that one of the parts of your body perish, than for your whole body to be thrown into hell." (also Matt.18:8-9)
- ➡ Matt.6:14-15 "But if you do not forgive men, then your Father will not forgive your transgressions."
- ➡ Matt.7:19 "Every tree that does not bear good fruit is cut down and thrown into the fire."

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Paul is contrasting life under the O.C. Law (slavery) with life under the N.C. (sonship).


The bad news Fear kills Love.

1 John 4:18

"There is no fear in love, but perfect **love casts out fear**,"





Note the way Paul starts ch.8:

Romans 8

"1 There is therefore now no condemnation for those who are in Christ Jesus. 2 For the law of the Spirit of life in Christ Jesus has set you free from the law of sin and of death. 3 For what the Law could not do, weak as it was through the flesh, God did: sending His own Son in the likeness of sinful flesh and as an offering for sin, He condemned sin in the flesh,"

The theme is "No Condemnation in Christ".

Note the way Paul concludes ch.8: Romans 8

"35 Who shall separate us from the love of Christ? Shall **tribulation**, or **distress**, or **persecution**, or **famine**, or **nakedness**, or **peril**, or **sword**? 36 Just as it is written, "For Thy sake we are being put to death all day long; We were considered as sheep to be slaughtered." 37 But in all these things we overwhelmingly conquer through Him who loved us. 38 For I am convinced that neither death, nor life, nor angels, nor principalities, nor things present, nor things to come, nor powers, 39 nor height, nor depth, nor any other created thing, shall be able to separate us from the love of God, which is in Christ Jesus our Lord." 24

A "quiet time"

Time alone with the Paraclete (Spirit of Christ) is necessary in combating the confusion, stress, and loneliness of life.

It is the place where God can remind us of the truth, renew our mind, and reassure our soul

in preparation for the challenges of life.

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Mistakes we often make in facing fear.

- 1. We fail to recognize the power of fear in our lives.
- 2. We trust God to do something other than change our perspective.
- 3. We fail to respect the fact that fear is most often a love issue.
