Rom.5:9 "having now been justified by His blood, we shall be saved from the wrath of God through Him"







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
John 5

"24 Truly, truly, I say to you, he who hears My word, and believes Him who sent Me, has eternal life, and does not come into judgment, but has passed out of death into life."

"28 Do not marvel at this; for an hour is coming, in which all who are in the tombs shall hear His voice, 29 and shall come forth; **those who did the good** {deeds} **to a resurrection of life, those who committed the evil** {deeds} **to a resurrection of judgment**."

John 6

"28 They said therefore to Him, "What shall we do, that we may work the works of God?" 29 Jesus answered and said to them, "**This is the work of God, that you believe in Him whom He has sent**.""



IN THE NEW TESTAMENT the final judgment is consistently based on WORKS (not FAITH).

2 Corinthians 5:10

"For we must all appear before the judgment seat of Christ, so that each one may be recompensed for his deeds in the body, **according to what he has done, whether good or bad**."





Sources of hope at the final judgment:


View #1 Dismissal - Remove the standard of holiness so that there is no offense.

View #2 Empowerment - Enable believers to meet the standard by the power of the Holy Spirit.

•The Holy Spirit empowers believers to fulfill the Law as a sign of saving faith.



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Romans 3

" $_{26}$ for the demonstration, I say, of His righteousness at the present time, so that He would be just and **the justifier of the one who has faith in Jesus**."


"28 For we maintain that **a man is** justified by faith apart from works of the Law."

Sources of hope at the final judgment:

- *View #1* **Dismissal Remove the standard of holiness** so that there is no offense.
- View #2 Empowerment Enable believers to meet the standard by the power of the Holy Spirit.

View #3 Redemption / Rewards - Believers are clothed with Christ's righteousness and rewarded for bearing God's image in the Body of Christ.



- This judgment is not about eternal life but about "rewards" and "loss" in ministry.
- Believers are rewarded for exercising their freedom from sin.
- This may have something to do with our worship posture in the Kingdom.

1. Believers will not face judgment or condemnation but have already passed into life!

John 5:24

"truly, truly, I say to you, he who hears My word, and believes Him who sent Me, has eternal life, and **does not come into judgment**, but has passed out of death into life."




"Therefore there is now **no condemnation** for those who are in Christ Jesus."

2. Our hope is not in the Law or the Holy Spirit but in the Cross & Resurrection of Christ!


Hebrews 7:18-19 "For, on the one hand, there is a setting aside of a former commandment because of its weakness and uselessness (for the Law made nothing perfect), and on the other hand there is a bringing in of **a better hope**, through which we draw near to God." Our better hope is in Jesus' life and death FOR us not in the Law fulfilled THROUGH us by the Holy Spirit.









Don't confuse the ministries of the Law, the Son, and the Spirit.









Revelation 20 John's version of the Final Judgement


"11 And I saw a **great white throne**, . . . 12 And I saw the dead, small and great, stand before God; and **the books were opened**: and **another book was opened**, which is the book of life: and the dead were judged out of those things which were written in the books, according to their works. 13 And the sea gave up the dead, which were in it; and death and Hades delivered up the dead, which were in them: and they were judged every man according to their works. 14 And death and hell were cast into the lake of fire. This is the second death. 15 And whosoever was not found written in the book of life was cast into the lake of fire." 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1 Corinthians 3


"11 For no man can lay **a foundation** other than the one which is laid, which is Jesus Christ. 12 Now if any man **builds upon the foundation** with gold, silver, precious stones, wood, hay, straw, 13 each man's work will become evident; for the day will show it, because it is to be revealed with fire; and the fire itself will test the quality of each man's work."


How we build on our saving faith is the issue.

"The day" = judgment day (1 Cor.1:8)

"14 If any man's work which he has built upon it remains, he shall **receive a reward**. 15 If any man's work is burned up, he shall **suffer loss**; but **he himself shall be saved**, yet so as through fire."

Reward and loss (not salvation) is the result of the believer's judgment.







1 Corinthians 4:5

"Therefore do not go on passing judgment before the time, but wait until the Lord comes who will both bring to light the things hidden in the darkness and **disclose the motives of men's hearts**; and then each man's praise will come to him from God."

Disclosure of what was hidden is the final judgment for believers.

Revelation 21:4

"and **He will wipe away every tear from their eyes**; and there will no longer be any death; there will no longer be any mourning, or crying, or pain; the first things have passed away."

> In the end there will be tears but they will be wiped away.

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
